REPORT OF OPERATIONS - JULY

At the beginning of July the 1st Battalion and Service Company were in the Belluno-Sedico area, the 2nd Battalion at Agordo, the 3rd Battalion in the Mis-Sospirolo area, and the Special Unit Companies on Lake Alleghe (4759).

Light training was continuing with emphasis on orientation, education athletics and recreation.

On 7 July the Special Unit Companies moved to Belluno and the Regimental Command Post opened at Belluno at 071000B July.

On 9 July the Regiment started movement by rail and organic motors to the Volturno Redeployment Training Area vicinity of Caserta, Italy and closed in this area 111700B July.

On 12 July Col Raymond C. Barlow assumed command of the Regiment vice Col Oliver W. Hughes who was transferred to 5th Army Headquarters.

Upon closing into the Volturno Redeployment Training Area all organizations continued training as in the previous areas with emphasis placed on subjects having disciplinary value such as military courtesy, close order drill, including ceremonies, interior guard duty and Articles of War. This continued as the period ended.

Strength of the command as the period opened was as follows: 125 assigned officers, 5 warrant officers, 2260 assigned enlisted men. At the end of the period the strength was as follows: 145 assigned officers, 5 warrant officers, 809 assigned enlisted men.
