REPORT OF OPERATIONS - JUNE

As the period opened the 1st Battalion and Service Company were in the Belluno-Sedico area, the 2nd Battalion at Agordo, the 3d Battalion in the Mis-Sospirolo area, and the Special Companies on Lake Alleghe (4759).

Light training continued throughout the month with emphasis on orientation, education, athletics, and recreation.

On 22 June at the Belluno air strip the regiment participated in a Field Day of athletics, military events, and horse racing. Competition was on a company versus company basis with "H" Company winning the most events.

On 26 June a billeting party representing this Regiment left for the Volturno Redeployment Training Area in the vicinity of Caserta, Italy.

As the period ended all organizations were still disposed as at the beginning of the month. Many changes in personnel had taken place both among officers and enlisted men during the month.

Strength of the command as the period opened was as follows: 168 assigned officers, 1 attached officer, 5 warrant officers, 3,273 assigned enlisted men and 19 attached enlisted men. At the end of the period the strength was as follows: 126 assigned officers, 5 warrant officers, 2,238 assigned enlisted men and 11 attached enlisted men.
